Interpreting the Past, Discovering the Future

- 21-24 August 2016
- Adelaide Convention Centre
- 720 attendees (all activities)
- 448 paid registrations
- 390 workshop attendees across 13 workshops
- 87 exhibition booths
- Forecast Surplus: \$232k gross
- ASEG: 65% (\$151k net)
- PESA: 25%
- AIG: 10%
- Considered practically and financially successful in very challenging economic circumstances. (very difficult to attract sponsors and large booth exhibitors). Attendance was on par with Adelaide 2009
- 90% of attendees responded that the conference overall was "Very Good or Good"

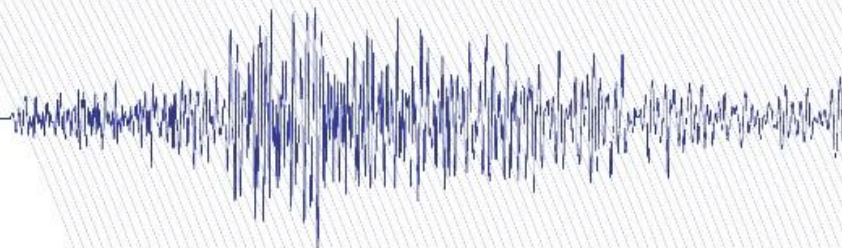

Membership by State Excluding WA 2016

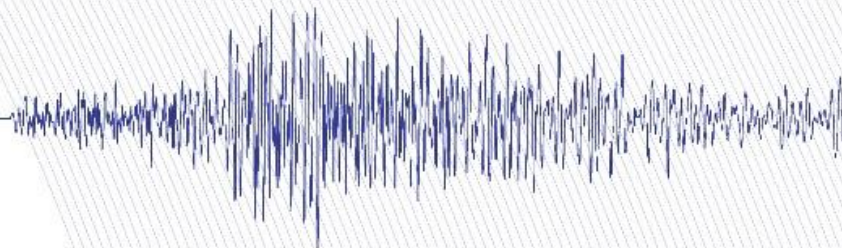

It is a chance to meet other Young Professionals in a relaxed, structured atmosphere. Think speed dating, but with board games and a conversation menu.

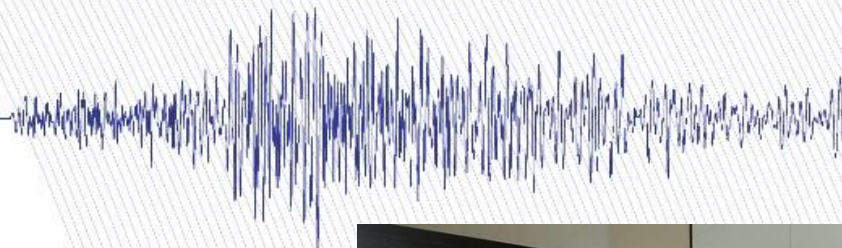
