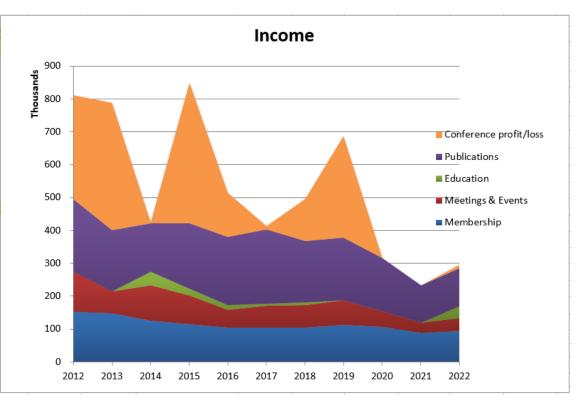

  The education category is picking up. The main income was from sponsorship received for the Camp for Applied Geophysics Excellence (CAGE).

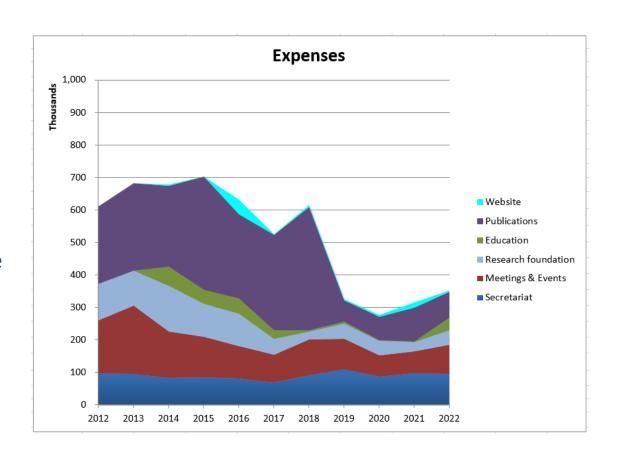

- Research Foundation the ASEG continues to offer scholarships to university students for their Masters and PhD studies.

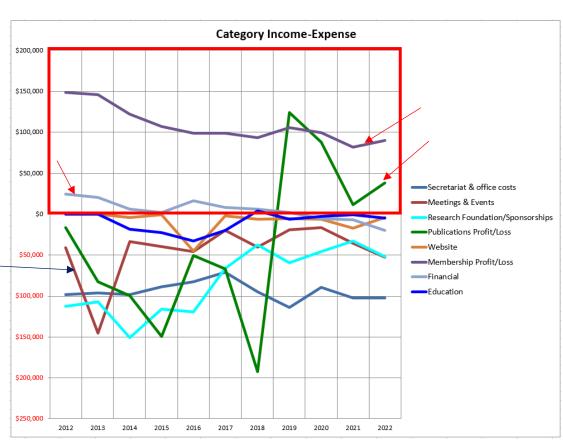

- Education, website and Research Foundation are a loss but important items to the society and its members





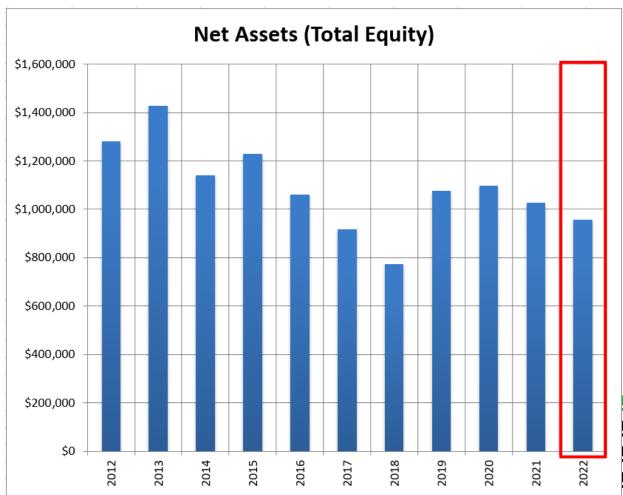
