Red: PRIMO ESTATE 1984 Cabernet Sauvignon

This beautiful blend was a clear winner with our selection panel. The wine has a rich, full-bodied style and has been aged for 11 months in a mixture of German, American and French puncheons. A rich middle palate and a subdued tannin-acid finish are characteristic of the Primo Estate wines, which have established an excellent reputation in the South Australian wine industry. The wine is ready for immediate consumption or can be cellared for up to five years for your future enjoyment. The price for ASEG members is only \$48 per dozen, which is exceptional value for this superb wine.

White: TOLLEYS 1986 Rhine Riesling

Again this year the Tolley's Rhine Riesling was by far the most impressive of the seven contenders. The well developed Rhine character derives from the judicious blending of grapes from both the Barossa Valley and Qualco Murray Valley. Those who enjoyed last year's ASEG Rhine Riesling will certainly be pleased at the opportunity of obtaining some more of this top quality wine.
